Mail shot to 55 properties (highlighted)

- A mail shot was sent to 55 properties within the immediate maze area on the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> July 2020. The mail shot explained the proposal and invited responses from residents which could be made via the Council website

- Information on the proposal and consultation was posted onto the Council Facebook page on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2020
- The Facebook post had a reach of 1,173 and 237 engagements

- The consultation period closed on 7<sup>th</sup> August 2020

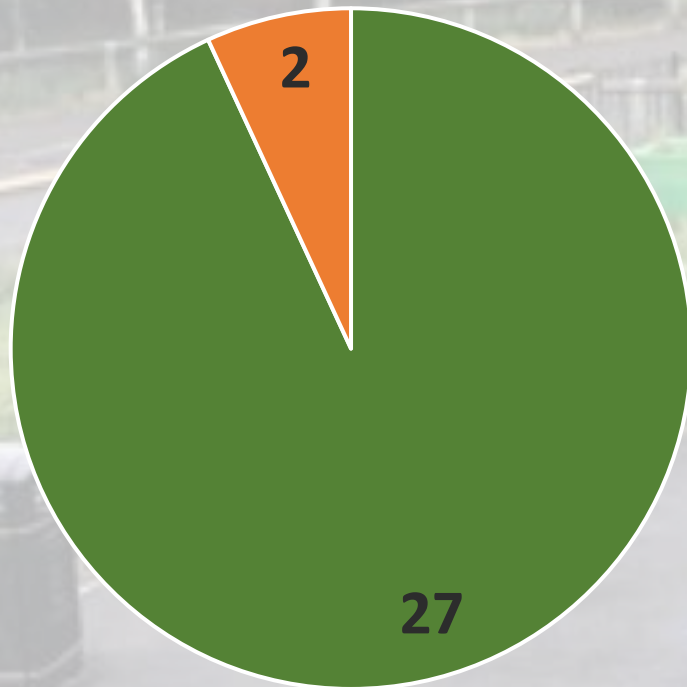

*Do you support the naming of the maze area to Maurice's Maze?*

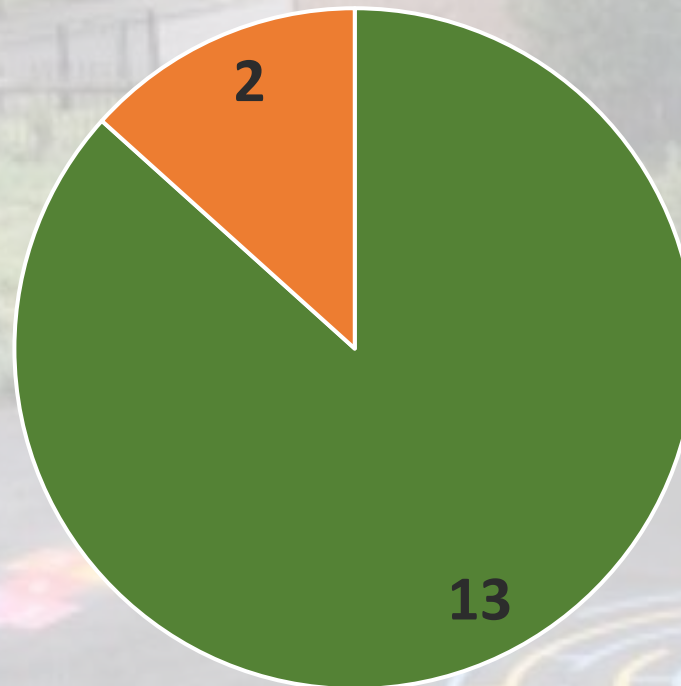


All Respondents  
93% Support



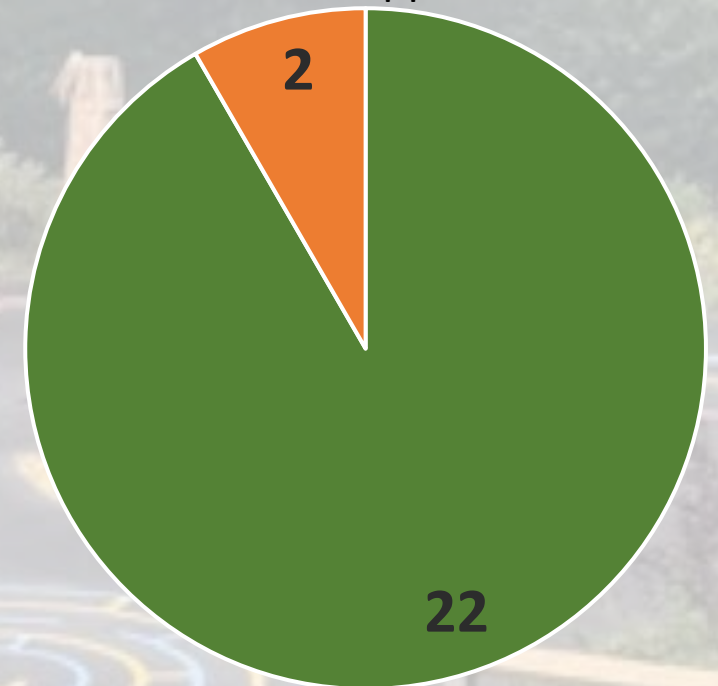
■ Yes ■ No
