 - Garden party in 2023
 It was agreed in principle that as the Jubilee Garden Party had been a great success and well received by residents, a Garden Party should be held in June/July 2023
 - Carol Singing in December 2022 It was agreed that the Carol Singing event should be held in December with refreshments provided.
 - Owl Farm, Rope has suggested a potential small quarterly "Farmer's Market" following their participation at the Jubilee Garden Party.
